We are renovating our new Ministry Center at 870 E 5th Ave. The space is perfect for youth discipleship, community outreach, skills training, and prayer gatherings. We call it the Resurrection Center, believing that many will find **New Life in Christ**.

We see beyond a construction zone to a space teeming with life, where people of all ages are **transformed by the gospel**. We envision young people telling their friends about Jesus, and getting academic assistance and exposure to trade skills. Together, let's equip a generation of young people for a life on-mission, across the block or across the globe!

Our total project cost is \$400,000, and below are a few of our **phase-one projects**:



## Rough-in Plumbing | \$42,000

We are adding 6 new restrooms to help make the Resurrection Center accessable and hospitble to everyone in our community.



## Security System | \$12,000

Safety is always our number-one priority for our youth, and a top-notch security system is just one of the ways we work to ensure their safety.



## **Termite Damage Repair | \$25,000**

You never know what is hiding beneath the surface until you start digging. We are thankful for a great team working on fixing old termite damage.



## Mold Remediation | \$12,000

The Resurrection Center suffered some water damage before it was gifted to RTNI. We are making sure that it is not only water-tight, but that there is no lingering mold.

RTNI is an Urban Ministry in Columbus, OH, serving in the Milo-Grogan, Linden, and Trevitt communities since 2007. We connect with students and families in hard places with the goal of life-on-life discipleship. We are intentionally present in our community and the lives of our youth. Relationships formed at scheduled programming often become discipleship opportunities and *life-long friendships*.

Being a part of each other's every-day lives allows ministry to be flexible and relevant, and the value of RTNI AS FAMILY has helped inform our programming.

## **HOW WE SERVE**

- Youth Programs: age specific Bible studies and mentoring groups
- Academic Help: reading, math, and science
- Skill Building: cooking, art, bicycle repair, lawn care, auto mechanics, etc.
- **Field Trips**: team building, citizenship, fitness, art, agriculture, leadership, college visits, and civil and global human rights
- **Community**: prayer tent at the corner store, safe places to connect, and an organic produce garden

Daily discipleship is our most important work. Apart from programming, students and neighbors stop by RTNI ministry houses to connect with staff and interns (2,000+ visits per year). We build trust, process hard issues, and celebrate transformation through life-on-life discipleship.

When Aaron and Emily Starr moved to Milo-Grogan with a vision to **disciple people in hard places**, Reaching the Nations International (RTNI) was born.

The Starrs made their personal home on 2nd Avenue a base of ministry in February 2007, and since that time, more than 1,500 youth have spent time in their home or participated in RTNI activities. Neighbors of all ages come to their home to enjoy playing games, sharing food, and talking about how **God impacts their every-day lives**.

RTNI started in Milo-Grogan, and has grown to serve families in the Linden and Trevitt communities. We partner with dozens of churches and organizations to see transformative, Christ-centered change in our communities.

Twenty-one School of Servanthood participants have lived in our three ministry houses, serving youth and neighbors. Over 1,000 volunteers have been a part of the RTNI family, and each have been changed by the bright, tenacious youth they serve.

RTNI recognizes urban youth as **uniquely equipped to be leaders** and influencers for the Kingdom of God because of their connection to both the suffering and compassion of Jesus.

Spending time with students, families and alumni on an everyday basis is our heartbeat.



I met Aaron and Emily when I was six years old at Jesus Fun Days in my neighborhood. The activities were fun and I went every Saturday for three or four years. I remember we did water balloons every week, and one time I made a hopscotch that was super long. Going to Bible study helped me get a lot closer to God than I was before. The leaders there taught me how to follow His path. I have learned that **God is powerful**, He died for our sins, and He will forgive you for anything. Growing closer to God has given me someone to look up to who is bigger than anyone. I can talk to Him and feel safe." – Joy, age 18

"Hi, my name is Jami. I've been in Young Disciples since I was 4. I have learned that God is over us, protecting us, and we need to respect him. The devil is a creature that only wants chaos in the world, and God only wants peace and love in the world. God loves us even more than other people love us. So that is why we should believe in God and love Him always." – Jami, age 10

"When I first came to Bible Study I would show a lot of anger and have a lot of energy, but the leadership of RTNI taught me that it's ok to relax and be calm. Sometimes I don't talk a lot at Bible study, but I like to come and just listen. Bible studies and tutoring are a lot of fun and you get to learn about God. What could be better than that? I have so many good memories, but my favorite is when more than 50 of us go to the Marmon Valley Horse Farm each year at Christmas time. It's good to be with my siblings, friends, and the larger RTNI Family - reliving the excitement of the birth of Jesus, eating cookies, and drinking hot chocolate. This is a childhood memory I will never forget. – Ni'Asia, age 19

"I am a Young Disciple, and I go to Bible Study, read the Bible, pray, and remember God. I think that Bible Study is amazing for kids who want to learn about God because God helped poor people, blind people, and people who did not have water. But people still put him on the cross in return. He gave us everything we needed, but we gave him pain and misery." – Revel, age 11
